Other approximate fees: The student will be responsible for purchasing textbooks, educational materials, uniforms (if applicable), and cost for transportation and for other expenses during the terms and the externship. These expenses can amount to approximately five hundred dollars (\$500.00) to one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for the duration of the study program. Details of the expenses for each program in terms of textbooks, materials, equipment and uniforms are stated in the Expenses Chart provided at the Advertising and Admission Office. It is the institution's policy that when there are costs increases for the technical programs, it only affects the new and readmission students. Students who do not receive any financial aid must pay the tuition of one academic term in advance during the enrollment process. Nevertheless, the institution allows the student to pay tuition for the academic term during the first week of each month.
